

Public Examination Results

Grade boundaries have returned to those of 2019 (the last year of public exam results before the pandemic). This year, no adjustment has been made for any loss of learning from the Covid 19 pandemic.

A Level Results – 2024

- The overall pass rate this year was 97% (2023 = 99%).
- The percentage of A* and A grades increased on last year at 29% (2023 26%) Students achieved twice as many A* grades (15, compared with 7 last year) distributed across a range of academic subjects, including Ceramics, Computer Science, Drama, DT, English Literature and Maths.
- The number of A*-C grades was the same as last year (76%). 58% of all grades achieved were grade A*-B or higher (2023 53%).
- The number of A* - C grades was 75% (2023 76%)
- The Art, Ceramics, Drama, DT, English Literature, Film Studies, French, Further Maths and Music departments were successful in achieving 100% grades A*-C.
- Of the 56 pupils in Upper 6th, 31 pupils (56%) achieved at least one grade A* or A (or Distinction/Distinction* for Cambridge Technical) and 16 (29%) gained grades at exclusively B or above.
- On results day, 83% of students were accepted with their first or second choice university. All pupils are now placed or taking a gap year.

GCSE Results 2023

- The overall 9-4 'pass' rate this year is 89.7% (88% 2023).
- Of the 585 GCSE and IGCSE exam entries for Upper 5th, over one third (37%) gained an A grade or equivalent (Grade 7-9). Over half of all entries gained grade 6 or above (56%) (2023: 35% and 54% respectively).
- The following subjects had a 100% pass rate at 9-4 (number of candidates shown in brackets): Art (17), Biology (17), Ceramics (8), Chemistry (17), Drama (23), Film (4), German (5), Latin (2), Music (11), Physics (17), RS (12), Spanish (4), and Sport Science (6).
- Drama (23), Film Studies (4), German (5) and Latin (2) did particularly well with all pupils gaining a grade 5 or above.
